I. School Statistics

- Founded in 2000
- Serving Grades 3 – 8
- School size approximately 106 max. with a 2009 configuration of 5 teachers and 3 teacher assistants.
- Class sizes for grades 3 – 4 is 18 and for 5 – 8 is 22
- School day: 180 days – Monday through Friday – 8:30 am to 3:00 pm daily
- Average staff/student ratio for 2009 is 11/1
- Average tenure for all staff is 4.8 years, and for teachers is 5.3 years

III. Student Body & Best Placement

The school provides a small educational setting and utilizes an integrated curriculum with special focus on the fundamentals of reading, writing and mathematics. Enrichment and remediation are provided through class, small group, pullout and individualized activities/lessons.

The school is a good place for the following categories of students:

- Students who may be SLD, OHI, ADD, ADHD;
- Students who are gifted, and may be immature for their grade levels or who do not do well in large, active settings;
- Regular ed. students who prefer, or simply do better in a small, focused educational setting where they either do not change classes or do so infrequently.

The school's 2009 student population is comprised of approximately 32% SLD, OHI, ADD, ADHD, Gifted, or students with 504 plans. Approximately 68% of the school's students are regular ed. who do not qualify for accommodations or services, and require infrequent support.
